Only E-Payments Will Be Accepted from 1 August 2023

From 1 August 2023, LTA will no longer accept cash, cashier's order and cheque payments for all transactions. This is part of the Authority's move to promote electronic payments.

For your convenience, customers can register for direct debit GIRO deduction via the 'Apply for GIRO Road Tax Renewal' digital service, or make payment to LTA securely via our other digital services at <u>onemotoring.lta.gov.sg</u> using the following payment modes:

- Internet Banking via eNets Debit (DBS/POSB, OCBC, Standard Chartered Bank or UOB)
- Any VISA/MasterCard credit or debit card¹
- ApplePay, GooglePay, or PayPal
- SGQR PayNow

Payments can also be made via the AXS and SAM platforms for selected LTA services².

For transactions that are done over LTA's counters, customers can pay with NETS, SGQR PayNow or Diners Club cards for vehicle registration and licensing-related services.
